During the November 13, 2025 City Council meeting, the City of Lago Vista recognized the service of Mayor Kevin Sullivan, Mayor Pro-Tem Rob Durbin, and Council Member Paul Roberts, each of whom completed their terms this November. The occasion provided an opportunity to acknowledge their years of leadership, volunteerism, and dedication to the Lago Vista community.

Mayor Kevin Sullivan has long been an active figure in town, contributing through youth sports coaching, scouting leadership, church service roles, and volunteer work with local organizations including the LVPOA and the Lions Club. He previously served on the City Council beginning in 2016 and returned as Mayor for the past two years, where he emphasized responsible use of tax dollars, strategic infrastructure investment, and sustainable growth. His open and approachable leadership style strengthened communication between residents and City administration.

Mayor Pro-Tem Rob Durbin's service has been characterized by his extensive involvement in both judicial and civic roles. His contributions to the City include serving on the Building Committee, chairing the Board of Adjustments, leading the 2021 Charter Review Committee, and serving as Associate Judge before being appointed Presiding Judge. Rob then continued his service on the City Council for approximately eight years, including the most recent year as Mayor Pro-Tem. His institutional knowledge, historical perspective, and thoughtful approach to policy discussions have been invaluable to the governance of Lago Vista.

Council Member Paul Roberts has been a committed member of the Lago Vista community since 2016, when he and his family moved to town searching for a close-knit environment in which to raise their children. His civic involvement began as an attentive and engaged citizen regularly attending Council and committee meetings, which eventually led to his appointment to Council in 2020 and his election to Place 5 in 2021. Paul served as Chair of the Economic Development Advisory Committee, and as a member of both the Building & Standards Commission and the 2021 Charter Review Committee. He has been a thoughtful advocate for public safety, preservation of green space, and responsible long-term planning.

The meeting also marked a moment of transition as Council Member Shane Saum was elected as the new Mayor, and newly appointed Council Members Karen Van Ness (Place 5), Jess Hall Jr. (Place 1), and Amanda Chavarria (Place 3) officially joined the Council. Their arrival represents the beginning of a new chapter in leadership while building upon the foundation established by the outgoing members.

As Lago Vista looks ahead, the City expresses deep gratitude to Mayor Sullivan, Mayor Pro-Tem Durbin, and Council Member Roberts for their service and commitment throughout their years of involvement. Their contributions have helped shape the future trajectory of Lago Vista, and the community looks forward to the continued progress and collaboration under the guidance of both new and returning Council Members.


## Winter Sewer Averaging

Your actual water usage during the months of November 2025 - February 2026 are reviewed to determine your sewer rate for your monthly bill. The lowest two months of metered water usage of those four are then averaged to determine your new sewer rate. These months are deliberately chosen because they tend to have the lowest consumption for most customers. The end result is that those who are conservative in their usage will pay less for sewer services. Those who use more water and place a greater burden on the treatment facilities will pay more. New winter averaging rates will be calculated in April of 2026 and due on your bills beginning in May 2026.
