
Introduction

This has been a very productive month for the Police Department, particularly in the area of training. During this month, our officers attended training in defensive tactics, active shooter response, crisis intervention, investigating cybercrimes and internet crimes against children, and leadership training. Several of these courses were “train-the-trainer” courses which will allow us to bring several of these critical topics back to other officers at our department.

On personnel matters, we received one resignation from Corporal Villarreal who accepted a position with the Travis County Sheriff's Office. We also filled our last vacant Dispatcher position with the hiring of Kathryn Palmer. She has begun our intensive dispatch training program which last several weeks until she is able to work on her own.

Additionally, we have been working hard this month on obtaining and evaluating information for the radio replacement project and Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) / Records Management Systems (RMS) replacement project discussed during the City Council's strategic planning session, in preparation for further discussions on these topics during the budget process.

Finally, it was a fantastic month for interacting with our community! We hosted our monthly Coffee with Cops and our officers were very present in our local schools, a few of us even got to sign some yearbooks and join in on some last day of school activities!






Calls for Service – Historical and Year-to-Date




Calls for Service – 2022 by Month
