


## Introduction

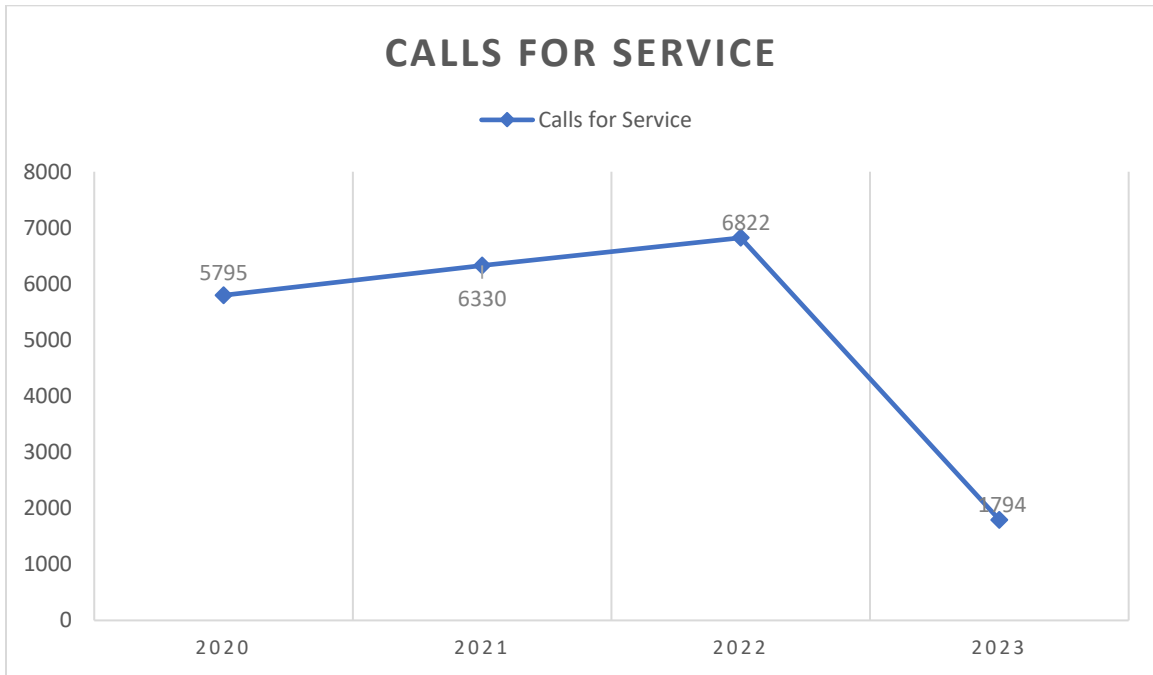

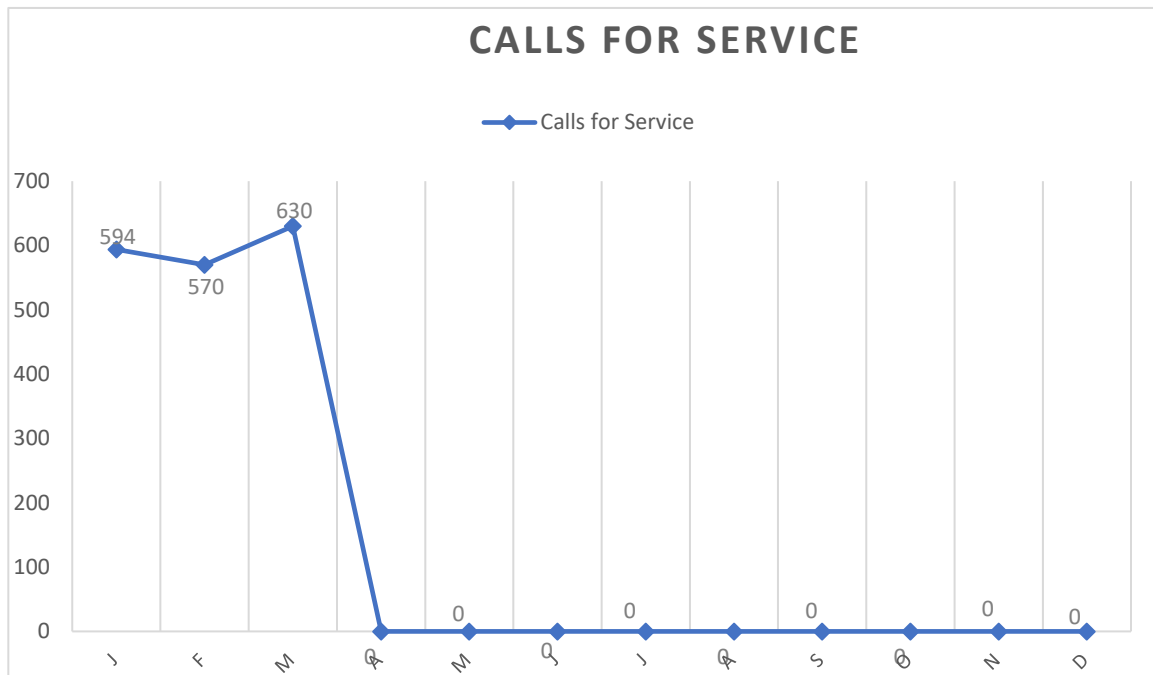

## Calls for Service – Historical and Year-to-Date

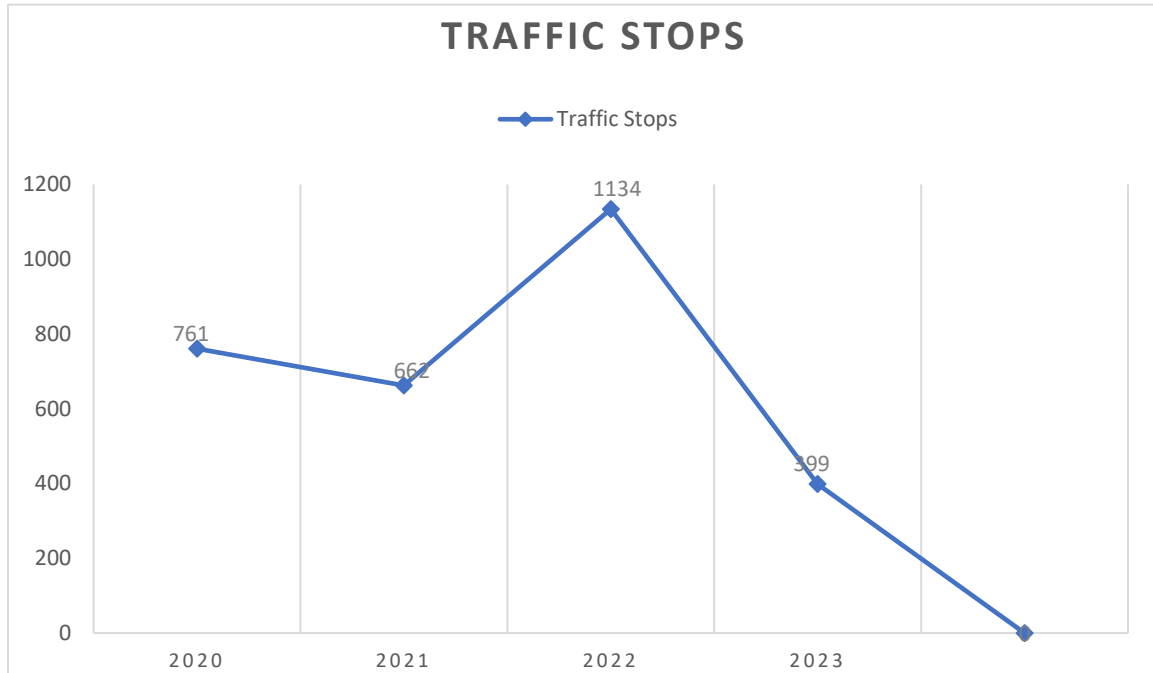


## Calls for Service – 2022 by Month

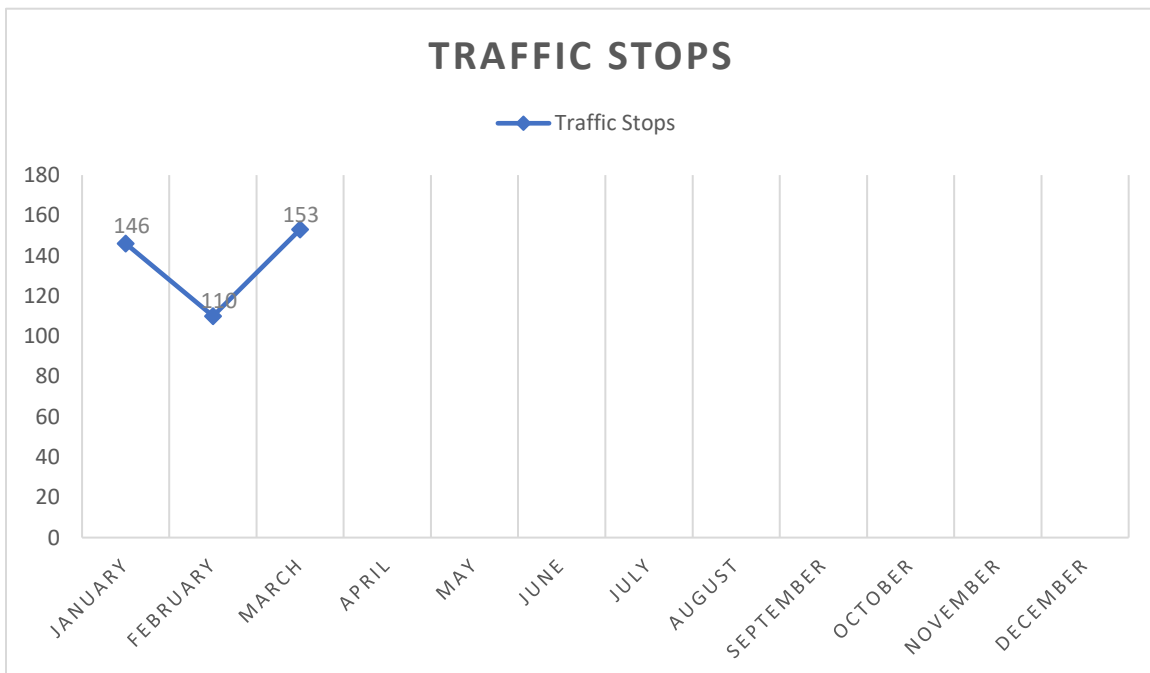




## Traffic Stops - Historical & Year-To-Date
