In addition to the Library's book clubs, children's programs, and other ongoing programs, several special programs were held in the Library Meeting Room during the month. A Wildfire Awareness Townhall Meeting was hosted by the Northshore Travis Firewise Group and presented by Will Boettner from the Travis County Fire Marshall's office. Licensed Insurance Agent and Medicare Specialist, Lee Green provided a Medicare 101 program to answer questions and share the basics of Medicare. Gerontologist and Clinical Profession of Sociology, Dr. Christopher J. Johnson presented an Alzheimer's program designed for caretakers of people with dementia.

Library staff worked closely with the Friends of the Library (FOL) Board on two special fundraiser events during the month, the Book & Bake Sale and the FOL Membership Fundraiser Dinner. The two events earned an estimated \$11,000 to benefit the Library.
