Library membership cards must be renewed every three years. The number of "patrons on file" includes anyone who has applied for a library card, whether the card has expired or not. Members are deleted upon request or if they have died or moved away from the area. The number of "patrons with active accounts," which changes on a daily basis, includes members whose cards have not expired or have been renewed.

Since COVID-19 became a threat, the Library paused its in-house story time for children. Staff offered a virtual story time each week that parents and children can access at their convenience; however, the number of children watching the videos cannot be validated. In-house storytime resumes March 2.

The total number of "adult programs" includes those groups, classes, or clubs that have resumed using the library meeting room as well as those who are temporarily continuing with virtual meetings.

The "amount saved by patrons" is an estimate of the dollar amount that patrons would have to spend if they were purchasing books, audiobooks, or DVDs rather than checking them out from the Library.

The amount of money spent on the Library by the Friends of the Library for the month of February is not known at this time.
