Two of our supervisors attended the second block of a leadership development program from the Texas Police Chief's Association. We trained several of our officers in Sexual Assault and Family Violence Investigations, a statewide training program for which I am an instructor, and we will be providing to all of our staff over the course of a few weeks period.

We spent time working with vendors this month to prepare for the upcoming fiscal year budget, developing plans for major issues that were discussed during strategic planning including replacement of the department's Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) / Records Management System (RMS) and replacement of the department's radio systems. 




Calls for Service – Historical and Year-to-Date




Calls for Service – 2022 by Month
