

**CITY OF LAGO VISTA, TEXAS
RESOLUTION NO. 22-1946**

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAGO VISTA, TEXAS APPOINTING JAMES M. BOLLENGIER AS THE FIRE MARSHAL SERVING THE CITY WITH THE AUTHORITY AND DUTY TO ENFORCE ALL APPLICABLE FIRE AND SAFETY CODES WITHIN THE MUNICIPAL LIMITS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lago Vista, Texas recognized the need for an individual or entity to serve as the designated City Fire Marshal by the adoption of Ordinance No. 85-03-27-04 and as amended by Ordinance No. 86-05-21-05 and Ordinance No. 93-10-21-05; and

WHEREAS, James M. Bollengier is an experienced fire inspector that recently relocated to the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, James M. Bollengier was recruited to join the Development Services Department staff with the intent that he would obtain the credentials required by the State of Texas to serve as the designated Fire Marshal for the City of Lago Vista, Texas; and

WHEREAS, James M. Bollengier obtained the required credentials from the Texas Commission on Fire Protection on October 25, 2021, evidenced by their issuance of Certificate Number 183772; and

WHEREAS, the formal appointment of an individual or entity to serve in this capacity appears to be consistent with current best practices to help ensure the health, safety and welfare of its citizens, yet was seemingly discontinued with the most recent appointment by resolution occurring in 1995; and

WHEREAS, James M. Bollengier is duly qualified to serve as the Fire Marshal for the City of Lago Vista, Texas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAGO VISTA, TEXAS:

THAT, the City Council of the City of Lago Vista, Texas does hereby appoint James M. Bollengier as the Fire Marshal serving the city with the authority and duty to enforce all applicable fire and safety codes within the municipal limits.
