### LAGO FEST HEADLINER: Shinyribs

SHINYRIBS defies genres as a sonic melting pot of Texas blues, New Orleans R&B funk, horn-driven Memphis soul, country twang, border music, big band swing, and roots-rock. The Austin-based nine-piece (sometimes 10-piece) supergroup is led by Kevin Russell, the charismatic frontman with colorful suits and extravagant shoes who continuously swaps out an electric guitar for a ukulele and never falls short of creating a cinematic experience with on-stage antics that often include him donning a light-up cloak or leading a conga line through the crowd.



### Tomar and the FCs

Back by popular demand, Tomar and the FCs has been featured on the Desk Concert Series, played the Austin City Limits Music Festival, made yearly appearances at SXSW, and was voted in the top Five on The Austin Chronicle's Music Poll for Blues, Funk, and Soul. Their album "Heart Attack" was recorded and mixed with Grammy winning artist/engineer Adrian Quesada of the band Black Pumas who received six Grammy Award nominations in 2021, performed at the Grammys, and performed at President Biden's inauguration.



### Blue Water Highway

Packing glorious, three-part vocal harmonies and tight yet inventive musicianship, this Lone Star state-based quartet has critics hailing them as one of the brightest hopes for modern Americana. Blue Water Highway boasts three excellent albums including its latest - Paper Airplanes.

With true purpose one of the richest, most resonant voices you'll ever hear, Aaron's songs explore age-old themes of love, heartache, failure, and faith. They are classic in their influence and unpretentious in their delivery.
