QUALIFICATIONS

All candidates for City elective office shall:

- Meet all the requirements for the office prescribed by state law;
- Be a United States citizen;
- Be at least 21 years of age by the date of the election;
- Have not been determined by a final judgment of a court exercising probate jurisdiction to be totally mentally incapacitated or partially mentally incapacitated without the right to vote;
- Have not been finally convicted of a felony from which the person has not been pardoned or otherwise released from the resulting disabilities;
- Be a registered voter residing in the City or annexed area for at least one (1) year prior to the date of the election;
- Hold no other elected public office if elected;
- Not be a City employee;
- Not be in financial arrears to the City for any reason; and,
- Not file for more than one (1) office per election.

Reminder to Utility Customers Regarding

Utility Late Fees, Cutoff for Non-Payment, & Payment Plans for City of Lago Vista Utility Customers


(Full notice originally posted online and mailed to all customers on June 14, 2021)

Beginning in September 2021, the City will again start billing a \$15 late fee for past due balances and will resume cutting off utility accounts after two months of nonpayment.

During these next two months, City staff will be available to work with our customers to set up payment plans to arrange to pay off past due balances to avoid cut off. The payment plan is flexible and requires that the customer works with staff to devise a plan that the customer can manage. Upon agreement, the plan will then be signed and notarized by both the customer and staff. During the term of the payment plan, no late fees will be charged to the customer's account. The terms of a payment plan require that the customer pay the past due portion of their payment plan plus their current month's bill in full by the 15th of the month each month to avoid additional late fees or cut off.

If payment is not received by the 15th day of the month or if an account is cut off for non-payment, the payment plan becomes void and a \$50 reconnect fee plus the balance in full on the account must be paid to reinstate the account.

If your utility account is in arrears, City staff members are here to help you. Please call **512-267-1155, Option 4**, to speak to utility billing staff to see if a payment plan can help you get your utility account current.
