Pickup service is currently available weekdays between 10 a.m. and 6 p.m. The service will pick up customers from their location within 15 minutes or less. Pickup is a great way for customers in Lago Vista get to important destinations such as shopping, medical services, City Hall, the Library, parks, car repair business, special events and more. It's completely personalized.

To get started, download the app for iPhone or Android, register your account and book a trip. Customers are also able to hail a ride by calling 512-369-6200. A single ride costs just \$1.25 no matter where you go or how far within the Lago Vista service zone.

## January at the Library

Have you heard the exciting news about the Lago Vista Library? As our community is steadily growing, your library is as well! We're expanding the space, updating our facilities in ways that can better serve Lago Vista and the surrounding areas. After being delayed by COVID-19 shutdowns and restrictions, the project is back on track to creating an amazing new version of your Lago Vista Library!

The City is working with Danze & Davis Architects, Inc. to draw up a plan that will expand the size of the library, add new meeting room space, and increase the size of the City Council Chambers. Denelle Wrightson Library Planning & Design is working with library staff and members of the Library Design Committee to design a layout that will allow space in the current facility to flow seamlessly with space in the new addition.

Nearly doubling the size of the current footprint of the library, the completed project will allow for larger Children's and Teen areas, more space for adult seating and computer users, a couple of quiet study rooms, additional meeting space and more!

Coming in 2021, this new and improved version of the Lago Vista Library will offer benefits to everyone in the community! We appreciate the community's support and will keep you updated as the Library/City Hall expansion project progresses!
