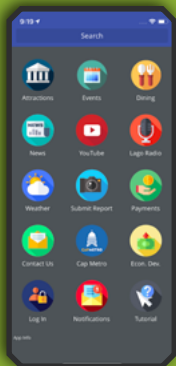

LITTER FACT: If every person in Texas picked up just two pieces of trash every month, our streets and highways would be completely litter free in just one year.

Most of the litter along Lago Vista streets and roads comes from people intentionally throwing trash out the window. If you see someone littering, note the license number, car description, and location. Report it online at dontmesswithtexas.org. TxDOT compares the information through the Department of Motor Vehicles registration database and when an exact match is located, we send the litterer a Don't Mess with Texas litterbag along with a letter kindly reminding them to keep their trash off of our roads.

July 2020 Library News

The Library has reopened with the following limited hours and **Grab & Go Guidelines**:

- **Open Monday – Friday 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. (Closed Saturday & Sunday)**
- Stay home if you are not feeling well.
- Limit your time in the building to 30 minutes or less.
- Use a face mask while inside the library.
- Use hand sanitizer (available at desk) upon entering the building.
- Observe social distancing – stay six feet apart from non-family members.
- Children may not be left unattended at any time.
- Toys, seating, and meeting rooms are not available at this time.
- Returned materials will be quarantined for 72 hours before reshelfing or checking out.
- A limited number of computers are available for specific, necessary tasks and not for general entertainment. Computer use is limited to 30 minutes.
- Copies, faxes, and scans will be made by library staff.
- **Curbside delivery is still available and encouraged.**
