


## Responding to the 2020 Census Crucial to Lago Vista Residents

**FACT:** Not responding to the 2020 Census costs Lago Vista residents exorbitant amounts in local, state, and federal funding. **HOW DO I RESPOND?** Responding to the 2020 Census is secure, easy, and takes only five minutes to do. There is no need to find the Census form letter that may have been mailed to you. Census response info is NOT shared with any other agency including INS, ICE, IRS, banks, employers, courts, etc. **Census response data is tied to your street address within 78645**, so if your confirmation page shows your city as Leander, **your response will still be registered as Lago Vista**. To avoid this, remember to fill out the "City" field as Lago Vista.
