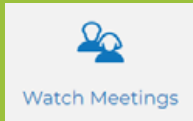

The Lago Vista City Council voted to reinstate charging all credit and debit card payments, a processing fee to help cover the City's cost for accepting credit and debit card payments. Effective December 1, 2023, a 3% fee will apply across the board to all departments: Golf Course, Court, Utilities, Police Department, Development Services, My Permits Now permitting system, and the Airport fuel farm.

## October At The Library

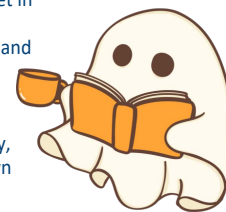
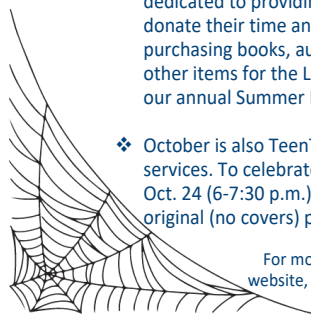

How does littering affect the river?

Plastic and organic litter can change the structure of river habitats, reduce the light level in the waters beneath the debris, and even deplete the dissolved oxygen in the water.

**DO NOT LITTER!** Carry a bag for waste along in the car to eliminate the possibility of accidentally littering. Put litter in your pocket until you find a recycling container or trash can.

**Recycle and reuse items whenever possible.**

Pick up **ONE** piece of litter every day! That's 365 less pieces of litter on our streets, in our parks, and around our schools thanks to you. Imagine if everyone picked up just one piece!

Make sure your trash bins have lids that can be securely attached. Do not put out open containers or boxes filled with debris.

Keep litter out of pick up truck beds and cover loads so items are not blown off to the ground.
