**RESOLUTION No. 21-1898**

**A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAGO VISTA, TEXAS  
ADOPTING AN OFFICIAL NEWSPAPER FOR THE CITY OF LAGO VISTA**

WHEREAS, on March 3, 2005, the City Council of the City of Lago Vista designated the North Lake Travis Log as the official newspaper of the City of Lago Vista, Texas; and

WHEREAS, the North Lake Travis Log is no longer in operation; and

WHEREAS, Texas Government Code Section 52.013(b) requires publication of ordinances in the municipality's official newspaper if the City's Charter does not provide another method for such publication.

WHEREAS, the Texas Government Code Section 2051.044(a) provides that a newspaper used to convey official notices must as a general matter:

- (1) devote not less than 25 percent of its total column lineage to general interest items;
- (2) be published at least once each week;
- (3) be entered as second-class postal matter in the county where published; and
- (4) have been published regularly and continuously for at least 12 months before the governmental entity or representative publishes notice.

WHEREAS, the publisher of the Hill Country News has provided confirmation that the paper meets these criteria.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
LAGO VISTA, TEXAS:**

**THAT**, the facts and matters set forth in the preamble of this Resolution are hereby found to be true and correct.

**THAT**, the City Council of the City of Lago Vista, Texas does hereby adopt the Hill Country News as the official newspaper of the City of Lago Vista, Texas.

**THAT** it is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this resolution passed is open to the public and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by law.

**AND IT IS SO RESOLVED.**
