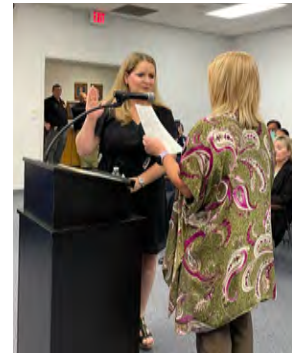

October 2023 was a busy month for Keep Lago Vista Beautiful. On October 14, KLVb sponsored a Group Litter Pick Up. More than 20 volunteers showed up to clean up the trash on 15 streets. They picked up 49 bags of trash, a tire, a water heater and a lot of construction materials along the streets. On October 18, 19, and 21 the City, assisted by KLVb, sponsored the City Wide Fall Clean Up. There were 553 vehicles that participated and the trash filled 15 dumpsters! On October 21, twenty-four Girl's Volleyball team members and their mothers and coaches picked up one long street, Silvester Ford. They collected 50 large bags of trash along with construction materials. A big "Thank You!" to all these volunteers who cleaned up our streets and helped out at the Trash Off.

Winter Sewer Averaging

Your actual water usage during the months of November 2023 - February 2024 are reviewed to determine your sewer rate for your monthly bill. The lowest two months of metered water usage of those four are then averaged to determine your new sewer rate. These months are deliberately chosen because they tend to have the lowest consumption for most customers. The end result is that those who are conservative in their usage will pay less for sewer services. Those who use more water and place a greater burden on the treatment facilities will pay more. New winter averaging rates will be calculated in April of 2024 and due on your bills beginning in May 2024.
