


Introduction

Additionally, we effectively filled vacancies within our Patrol and Communications Divisions.

Throughout the month, we conducted the first annual update training for our department. This comprehensive training covered crucial topics such as Use of Force, Less-Lethal Weapons, Defensive Tactics, and Self-Aid / Buddy-Aid, ensuring that all our officers remain well-versed in the latest protocols. This initiative aligns with our commitment to providing regular updates on these subjects, complementing the ongoing training efforts throughout the year.

A notable highlight of December was the commendation of several outstanding team members who exhibited exceptional dedication to both the department and the city over the past year. These individuals were recognized through our recently established annual awards, with recipients chosen by our command staff based on recommendations from team members. 




Calls for Service – Historical and Year-to-Date




Calls for Service – 2023 by Month


Summary
