

## **Monthly Report – April**

### **Parks and Recreation:**

April proved to be a bustling period for both Parks and Recreation (PNR) and Golf Course Maintenance (GCM). PNR sought council approval to contract for the replastering of the city pool, which was granted, prompting the contractor to initiate demolition work to pave the way for the plastering phase. Moreover, PNR experienced a staff resignation, prompting active efforts to fill the vacated position. Despite facing mechanical setbacks with equipment, all issues were promptly resolved, restoring regular maintenance operations. At Rusty Allen Airport, the FAA inspection resulted in a minimal punch list, primarily addressing minor tasks like changing light bulbs, all of which have been promptly addressed.

Meanwhile, GCM was engrossed in various tasks, including laying sod to level low areas on the #18 green, preparing for the Lyon's Club annual tournament, aerifying greens, and implementing agronomic strategies to enhance playing conditions at Lago Vista GC.
