

**CITY OF LAGO VISTA
ORDINANCE NO. 24-11-18-01**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAGO VISTA, TEXAS, CANVASSING THE RETURNS OF THE CITY OF LAGO VISTA'S NOVEMBER 5, 2023, GENERAL ELECTION FOR THE OFFICES OF COUNCIL MEMBER PLACE 2, COUNCIL MEMBER PLACE 4, AND COUNCIL MEMBER PLACE 6, EACH ELECTED ON AN AT LARGE BASIS.

WHEREAS, on November 5, 2024, a General Election was held at which the qualified voters of the City had the opportunity to vote for the purpose of electing the hereinafter named officials; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to and in compliance with the Texas Election Code, the City Council of the City of Lago Vista is required to canvass the returns of the General Election held on November 5, 2024, and the City Council having met to canvass the returns and to declare the results of said elections in the manner provided by law.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAGO VISTA, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. THAT, for the purpose of electing the hereinafter named officials, and it appears from said returns, that each of the candidates in said election received the following votes:

SECTION 2. THAT, said election was duly called, that notice of said election was given in accordance with law, and that said election was held in accordance with law; that **Adam C. Benefield** was duly elected to the office of Council Member Place 2, **Norma Owen** was duly elected to the office of Council Member Place 4; that **Paul Prince** was duly elected to the office of Council Member Place 6 each at large for the City of Lago Vista, Texas. Said above-named parties are hereby declared duly elected to their said respective offices, subject to the filing of their "Statement of Elected Official" and the taking of their "Oath of Office" as provided by the laws of the State of Texas. The Office term will commence at the regular Council meeting that

the member of the Council has been declared elected and duly qualified for office.

SECTION 3. THAT, the City Council further finds that such returns are correct and adopts them as the returns of the General Election, that a copy of the Official Cumulative Report is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein, and an Official Precinct Report is on file with the office of the City Secretary.

SECTION 4. THAT, it is found that the meeting of the City Council at which this Ordinance was adopted was open to the public and it is further found and determined that in accordance with the Order of this Governing Body that public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code.

SECTION 5. THAT, all ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, which are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and remain controlling as to the matters ordained herein.

SECTION 6. THAT, if any provision of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall be held to be invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance and the application of such provision to other persons and circumstances shall nevertheless be valid, and this Council hereby declares that this Ordinance would have been enacted without such invalid provision.

SECTION 7. THAT, the recitals contained in the preamble hereof are hereby found to be true, and such recitals are hereby made a part of this Ordinance for all purposes and are adopted as a part of the judgment and findings of the Council.

SECTION 8. THAT, this Ordinance shall be construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas and the United States of America.

SECTION 9. THAT, this Ordinance is effective immediately upon its passage and approval pursuant to City Charter Section 3.16.


