PUBLIC NOTICE: Lead Service Line Inventory Requirement



The City of Lago Vista (PWS ID: 2270092) has received two violations from the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for not submitting a required Lead Service Line Inventory (LSLI) by the October 17, 2024, deadline. While there is no known lead in our water system and no immediate risk to public health, federal and state regulations require all public water systems to inventory service lines to identify any potential lead components. The City is actively working to complete this inventory and submit it to TCEQ, with an anticipated completion date of September 2025. There is no action required from residents at this time, and the water remains safe to drink.


August Pool Schedule:
